

## AGRAMOX 150 LA - injectable solution



### Composition:

Each ml contains:  
150 mg Amoxicillin base

### Indications:

Amoxicillin is a semisynthetic broad-spectrum penicillin with a bactericidal action against both Gram-positive and Gram-negative bacteria. The range of effect includes *Campylobacter*, *Clostridium*, *Corynebacterium*, *E. coli*, *Erysipelothrix*, *Haemophilus*, *Pasteurella*, *Salmonella*, penicillinase negative *Staphylococcus* and *Streptococcus* spp. The bactericidal action is due to inhibition of cell wall synthesis. Amoxicillin is mainly excreted in urine. A major part can also be excreted in bile.

Agramox 150 LA is indicated for Infections caused by micro-organisms susceptible to amoxicillin, like infections of respiratory tract; alimentary tract, urogenital tract, secondary bacterial infections in calves, cattle, goats, sheep and swine.

### Contra-indications:

New-borns, small herbivores (such as guinea pigs, rabbits), hypersensitivity to penicillins, renal dysfunctions, bacterial infections caused by penicillinase-producing bacteria.

### Side-effects:

Hypersensitivity reactions.

### Dosage and Administration:

For intramuscular or subcutaneous administration:  
General: 1 ml per 10 kg body weight, repeatable if necessary after 48 hours.

### Recommendations and Warnings:

Shake well before use and do not administer more than 20 ml in cattle, more than 10 ml in swine and more than 5 ml in calves, sheep and goats per injection site.

**Withdrawal time:** For meat: 21 days. For milk: 3 days.

**Storage:** Keep in a cool and dry place, away from sunlight and safe from children.

### Packing:

48 vials of 100 ml in 1 carton.
